

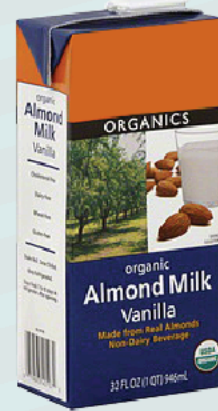

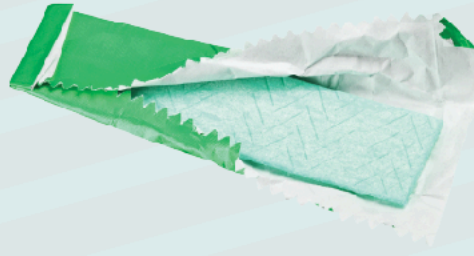

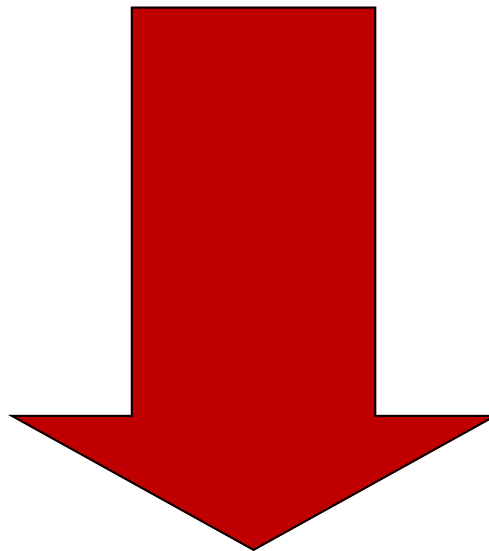

Please see list to right for details.</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Includes all food scraps, green waste, & food-soiled paper. 	<p>GREEN WASTE</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Grass clippings Flower & hedge trimmings Leaves & branches Lumber, scrap wood, & Plywood types (not painted or treated) Weeds <p>FOOD SCRAPS <i>*Any putrescible matter produced from human or animal food production, preparation, & consumption activities</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Bread, rice, & pasta Cheese & dairy Coffee filters & tea bags Flowers & herbs Fruits & vegetables Meat, bones, poultry, & seafood <p>FOOD-SOILED PAPER <i>*No bathroom tissue, toilet paper, or feminine products</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Compostable to-go containers/ serving-ware: must be 100% fiber based. Egg cartons (paper) Food-stained paper Napkins & kitchen towels Paper food boats (no plastic lining) Paper packaging Paper plates & cups Pizza boxes <p><i>We only accept specific compostable "bio-plastic" material.
